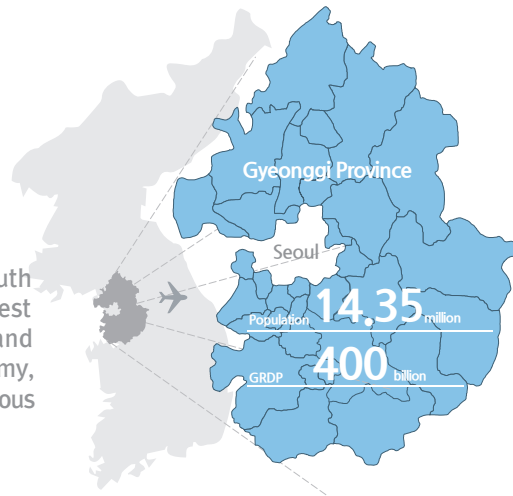


Gyeonggi Province

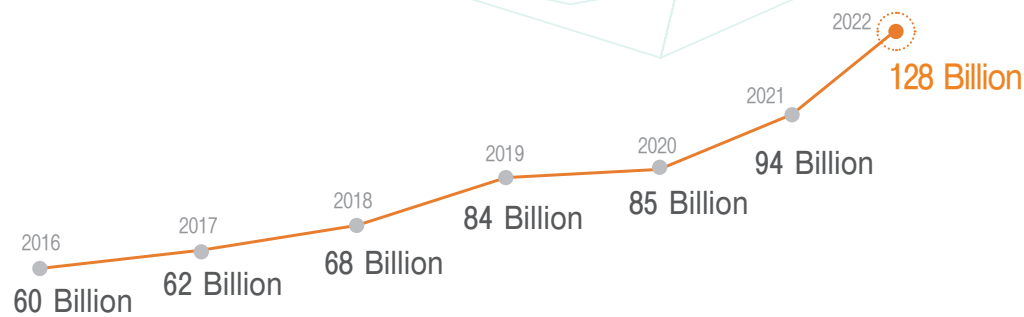

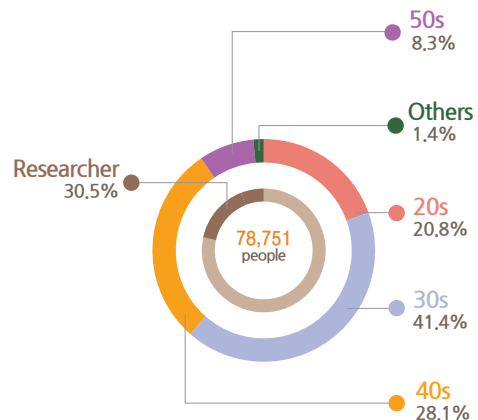

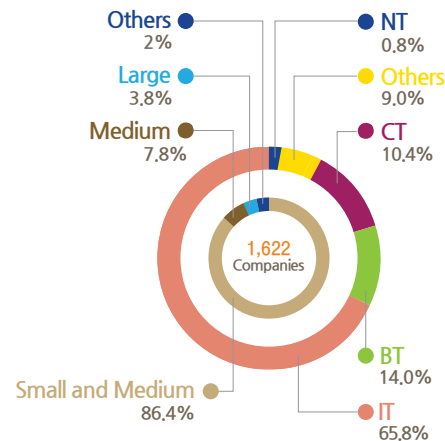
